



## No Sucker

Lollipop Tots combines Balinese prints and modern design for playwear with an exotic touch. Based in San Rafael, Calif., the brand launched in 2005 and incorporates the batik method of hand-painting and dyeing on girl's tunics, dresses, skirts, shorts and wide-leg pants.

"The style is very unique; it's a combination of traditional prints, new bright colors and new styles," said owner/designer Silvia Kenny, who is originally from Bali. She travels to the island nation where the clothing is manufactured twice a year to oversee production.

The thread for woven pieces is hand-selected for the correct feel and texture, and embroidered flowers and bright pink, orange and green colorways enhance the island look. While heavily influenced by traditional Balinese designs, Kenny said the 100-percent cotton line, which comes in sizes 2T to 10, fits with current trends. "We're using a modern-look batik," she said, adding "the combination of colors makes the prints pop." Wholesale prices for fall are \$15 to \$28.
